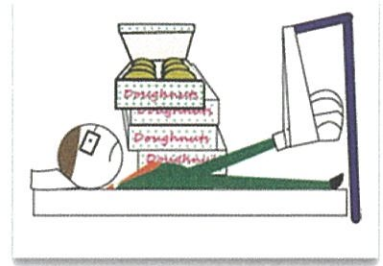


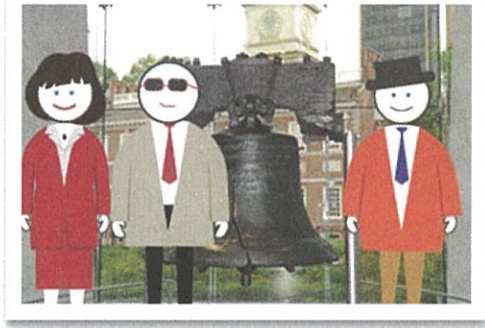
Greetings!
